A 124 Niche Romanesque Columbarium holding 28 Single Niches and 48 Double Niches is being installed this Fall in the Resurrection Garden adjacent to the Mausoleum.

This is the body once washed in Baptism anointed with the oil of salvation, and fed with the Bread of Life. Our identity and self-consciousness as a human person are expressed in and through the body...Thus the Church's reverence and care for the body grows out of a reverence for the person whom the Church now commends to the care of God.

From earliest times, Christians have desired that the faithful departed become the objects of the Christian community's prayers and remembrance. Tombs are places of prayer, remembrance and reflection... The Church asks, that in keeping with a spirit of reverence, the cremated remains be buried in a grave or entombed in a mausoleum or columbarium. According to Church doctrine, scattering human remains, keeping them in homes, or wearing them in jewelry does not show appropriate reverence for a human life.
